

COURSE EVALUATION QUESTIONS

Students respond to the following items on a five-point scale (with 5 being the high score). Students also have the option to offer open-ended written comments.

Focus on the instructor

1. The instructor met the class and/or lab on time and as scheduled.
2. The instructor presented material in an organized manner.
3. The instructor was enthusiastic about the material.
4. The instructor provided clear criteria about grading.
5. The instructor provided feedback about my performance suitable to the nature and size of the class.
6. The instructor returned graded materials within a reasonable amount of time, considering the nature of the assignment.

Focus on your experience

1. I acquired substantial knowledge and/or skills in the course.
2. I found the instructor's feedback useful.
3. I was encouraged to ask questions about the course material.
4. I found the instructor to be helpful in clarifying course material.
5. I was encouraged to reflect critically on course content.
6. I found the instructor to be available outside of class for help (e.g. during office hours, special appointments, via e-mail, telephone).

At the end of each semester, after final grades are submitted to the Registrar's office, an evaluation report is sent to the dean of the college, the instructor's chair, and the instructor.
