I am pleased to announce that Dr. Caitlin Finlayson has accepted the position of Faculty Program Director of the University Teaching Center. Caitie joined the UMW faculty as an adjunct instructor in 2012, and became a full-time tenure-track faculty member in the Department of Geography in 2014. She received her Ph.D. in Geography from Florida State University (2012) and has a B.A. in Philosophy and Religious Studies from Winthrop University (2007). Caitie was the 2018 recipient of the UMW Alumni Association Outstanding Young Faculty Award and has also been awarded a Jepson Fellowship.

In the coming months, Caitie will be working closely with UMW faculty and staff, the Division of Teaching and Learning Technologies, and other areas designed to support faculty teaching, to develop a plan for a new University Teaching Center that will harness the potential of existing resources and personnel to create a new structure that aligns with the University's strategic vision and supports all faculty, staff and students in our shared commitment to teaching and learning. The goal is to share this plan with the University community and obtain feedback during the spring semester, with a final plan for the University Teaching Center in place for implementation by Fall 2019.
